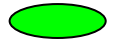

Outline information on entry requirements and future options.

The attached tables provide details of entry requirements and future options, including school, college and university courses, training and employment opportunities for all SQA courses offered. The options forms for S5 and S6 are also attached.

For full details on the purpose of each course (why take this course?), programme content (what will I learn?) and assessment procedures (How will I be assessed) please see the full Options Booklet which is available in **Public 1/Subject Choice** and on the school website on www.campbeltowngrammar.org.uk/. The Information Booklet also provides information on Core Subjects and on PSHE Options Programmes for S4 and S5.

It is important that you read carefully all of the information provided before you make your choices.

In the course of the next few weeks you will discuss options and next steps in your PSHE classes. You will also have the opportunity to discuss your choices individually with your Pupil Support Teacher. Your parents will be able to see the information booklet on the website address above. Parents of S5/6 students will be able to discuss options with your Subject and Pupil Support teachers at the Parents' Evening which will be take place on **2nd March.**

The choices which you make will be based on your performance in prelim examinations and in your course work.

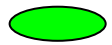
Following the issue of SQA exams in August you will be interviewed again by your Pupil Support Teacher to ensure that you have attained the qualifications required for entry into the courses you have chosen. If you have not met the requirements, you will be asked to choose an alternative subject. If you have done better than expected you may wish to alter your choices provided that there are places available in your new option.

However, entry into S5 and S6 is not based only on meeting the entry requirements for subjects. It is very important that pupils have demonstrated satisfactory commitment to their education by having the following:

- a high attendance rate;
- a positive attitude to work and
- a good behaviour record.

Consequently, when you are interviewed by your Pupil Support Teacher, your options form will be marked in the following ways:

A green sticker = you have met the above requirements



An orange sticker= you must demonstrate improvements one or more of the above areas in order to move into S5 or S6.



A red sticker= you have not met the requirements for entry into S5 or S6. The red sticker could also indicate that you have decided to leave in June, 2010.



Attached also are the Options Forms for the session 2010-2011. These are to be used in your discussions with your parents, Pupil Support Teachers, Careers advisor etc about options. The official forms for submission by **Friday, 12th March** will be issued at a later date.
